

Digital Duct Tape for Language Instructors II

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What is digital duct tape?

The act of creating or improvising problem-solving with basic tech tools to solve a teaching challenge. By including digital tools to create solutions to educational problems, you open opportunities to level up your online teaching materials, in class instruction and assessments. The following are a few tools and methods that may assist you as you are creating learning events or facilitating lessons.

Challenges - Technologies

1. Tracking learner engagement in virtual sessions - Big Blue Button dashboard
2. Organizing digital files - File/folder Renamers
3. Presenting video content in online hosts (LMS) - Embed or link
4. Expensive and Heavy/ Educational resources - Open Educational Resources

1. Documenting engagement in virtual sessions

- Teaching a fully online class with multiple students moving through a series of learning events over several hours.
- After a lunch break, this will happen again with another class.
- When do you have time to document activity in the first session?



1. Virtual dashboards – where can I find them?

- Online virtual meeting and classroom tools offer these
- The detail will vary between licenses of each product
- They normally appear to the hosts(s) after a session is complete.

Look for an Engagement, Analytics, Learning Analytics Dashboard tab / button

1. Virtual dashboards - what kind of information?

- Assessment & Progress Tracking
 - Document participation for PBLA or portfolio evidence
 - Track progress over time (identify trends)
 - Formative assessments (quiz, activities, polls)
 - Chat participation statistics
- Online Classroom Management
 - Ensure learners are actively present, not just logged in (for subsequent sessions)
 - Join and leave times
 - Time in session
 - Participant names
 - Session duration (start and finish times)
- Detect technical difficulties
 - Lack of engagement may indicate audio, connectivity, or platform issues

2. Organizing digital files

Why?

- Save time and reduce Stress
- Quickly find lesson plans, worksheets and assessments
- Avoid searching through multiple folders
- Reuse materials efficiently from previous courses

2. Organizing digital files

Benefits

- Support Collaboration with Colleagues
 - Share resources efficiently with co-teachers or program teams
- Build long-term resource banks (master files & copies)
- Reuse and adapt existing learning materials
- Avoid confusion caused by multiple file versions
- Maintain consistent versions of files

2. Organizing digital files

- To do this a file renaming app is essential

2. Renaming digital files (multiple)

1. Rename *multiple* files simultaneously
2. Find and replace text in file names
3. Change file extensions
4. Change folder names
5. Add or remove words or numbers
6. Change capitalization
7. Preview changes before applying new name

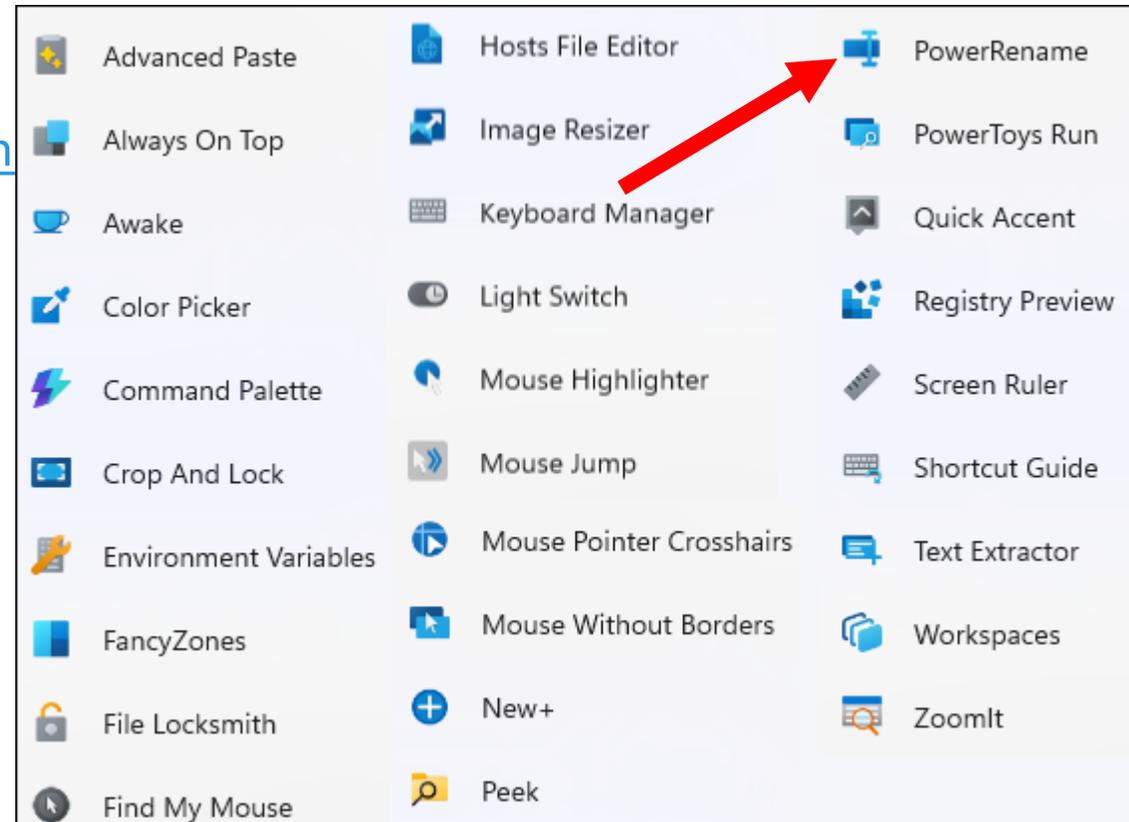

3. Why Hyperlink?

content is optional or supplementary

extra readings

reference materials

enrichment resources

Found on:

external websites

external or internal digital repositories

3. Hyperlink

The content changes frequently as in dynamic websites (news sources, weather, ephemeral websites resources like Breaking News English)

You want to:

- reduce page clutter

- keep loading times fast (less load on your server)

- avoid accessibility or copyright issues



3. Hyperlink

Accessibility, ensure there is a descriptive name to the link

Choose destination

- In pop up

- In same window

- In new window or in new tab

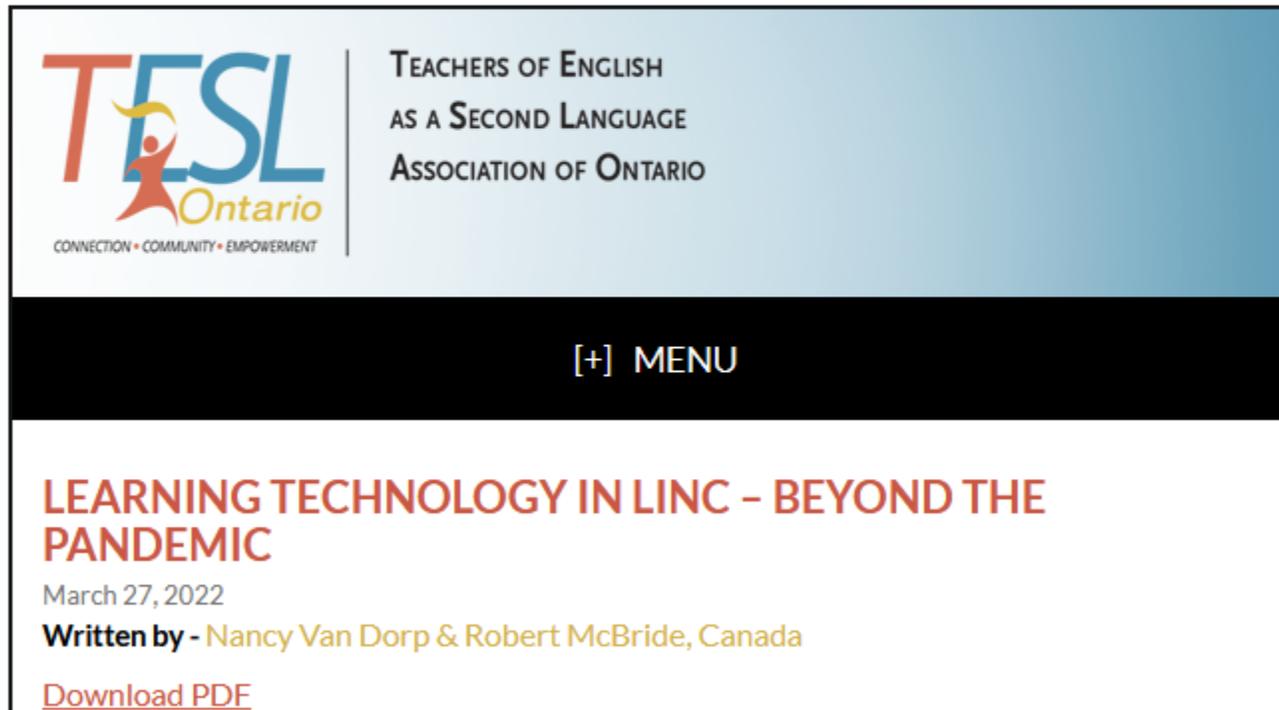

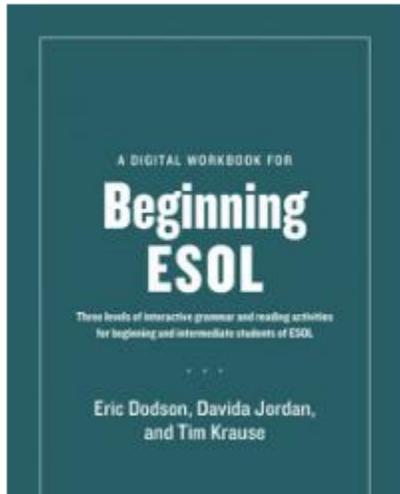

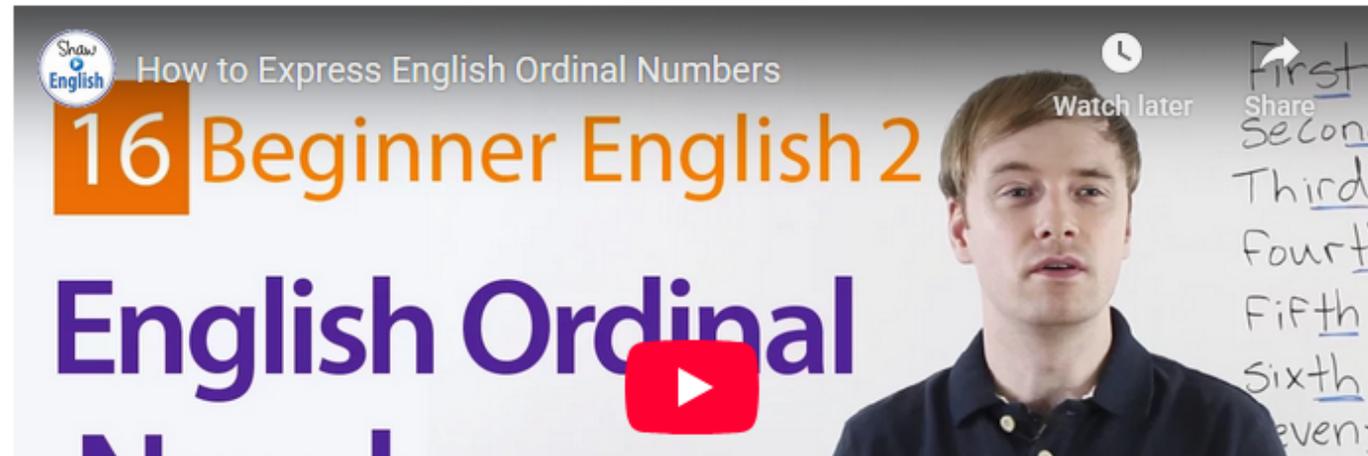

5. Collaborative Online Editors

- Collaborative online editors are digital tools that allow multiple people to create, edit, and review a document at the same time through a network.

5. Collaborative Online Editors

- Users can:
 - work together in real time
 - see changes instantly
 - leave comments or suggestions
 - track revisions and contributions
 - not be expected to email files back and forth

5. Collaborative Online Editors

- Learners can
 - co-write stories
 - complete group tasks
 - peer edit in real-time or asynchronously
 - brainstorm ideas
 - participate on projects create newsletter etc.

5. Collaborative Online Editor attributes

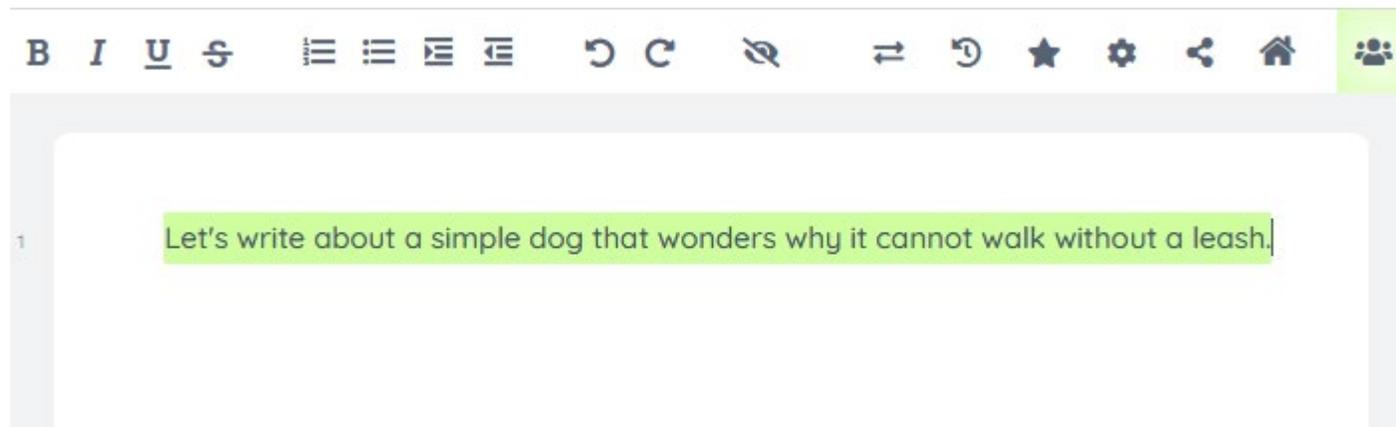

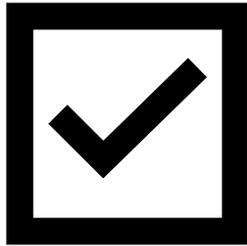

6. Activity completion

Activity completion is a feature in learning platforms (Moodle, Brightspace) that track whether learners have finished specific activities or tasks in a course. It helps both teachers and learners see learning progress quickly.



6. Activity completion

Characteristics,

- Automatically or manually mark an activity as complete based on
 - Open and view an activity
 - Receive a passing grade
 - Submit a task
 - Contribute a defined number of items (example: forum posts)
- A checkmark or progress indicator usually appears
- Some indicate unsuccessful attempts with a red X or with simple terms such as DONE

6. Activity completion

Learners

Shows what has been finished

Reduces confusion

Supports self-paced learning

Encourages motivation and progress tracking

6. Activity completion

Teachers

Set rules for activity completions

Monitor participation

Identify learners who need support

Track engagement in online courses

Structure step-by-step learning pathways

7. PowerPoints to Interactive videos

- Convert old or create new PowerPoint slide shows
- Repurpose them as interactive videos

7. PowerPoints to Interactive videos

- Open or create a PowerPoint slide show
 - High contrast and few items on each slide
 - Record or add audio to individual slides
 - Simple transitions
 - Appropriate slide timing
 - Enable captioning (if desired)

Dev – Make Interactive videos

Video + H5P interactive videos = interactive learning events



7. PowerPoints to Interactive videos

- Save PowerPoint slide show
- Export to Video
Settings, quality HD 720p (if uploaded to your server)
- Use recorded timings
- Format Mp4

7. PowerPoints to Interactive videos

- Start an interactive H5P
- Ideally link to the Video through YouTube
- Set key points in video (questions, comments, pauses)
- Publish as an H5P
- Add to an online course

- Prompt to create formatted text
- Copy the code text
- Open the H5P editor
 - Single Choice Set
 - Summary
 - Drag the Word
 - Question Set Multiple Choice)

- Paste the text into the H5P editor
