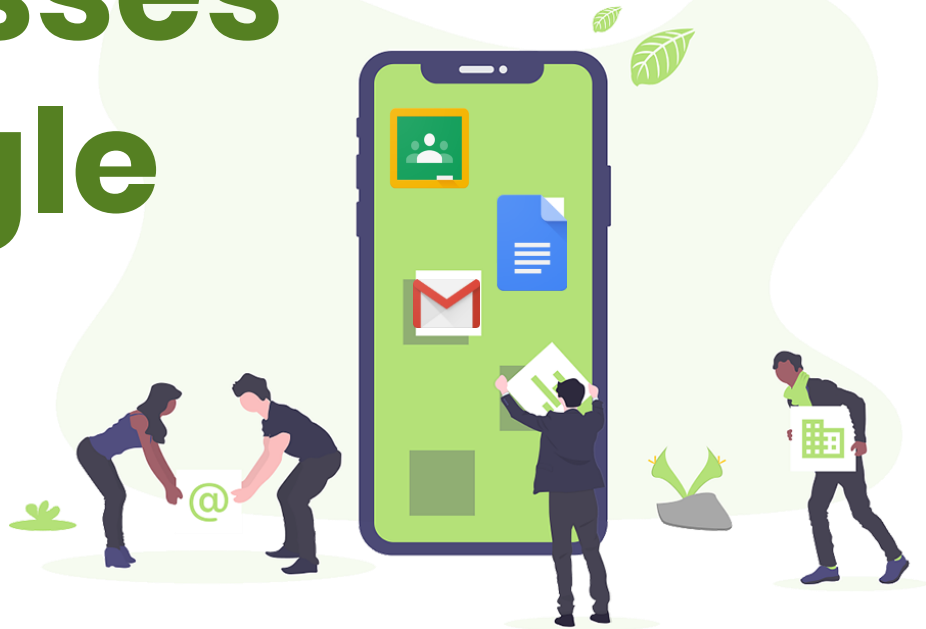

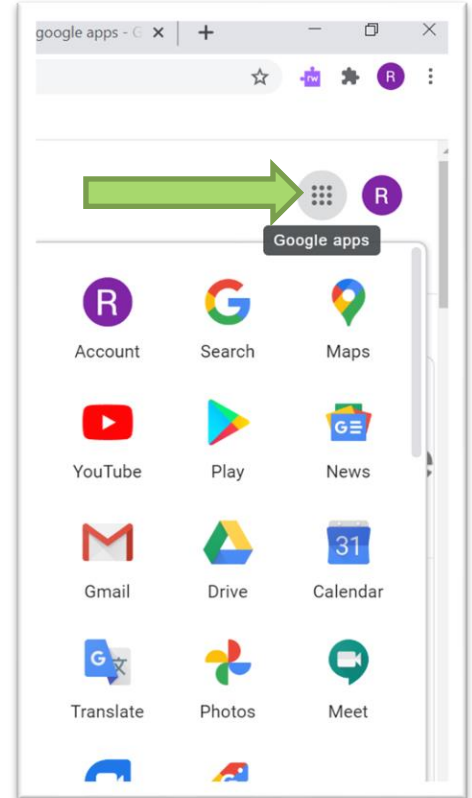
STEP 1

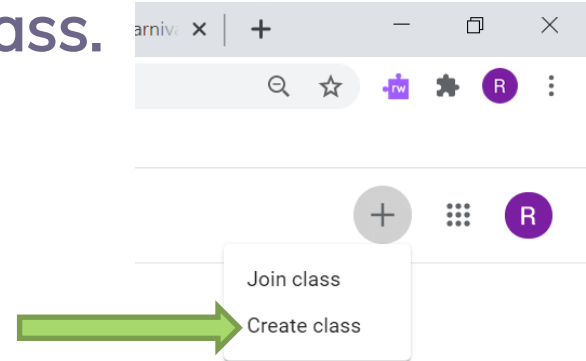
STEP 3

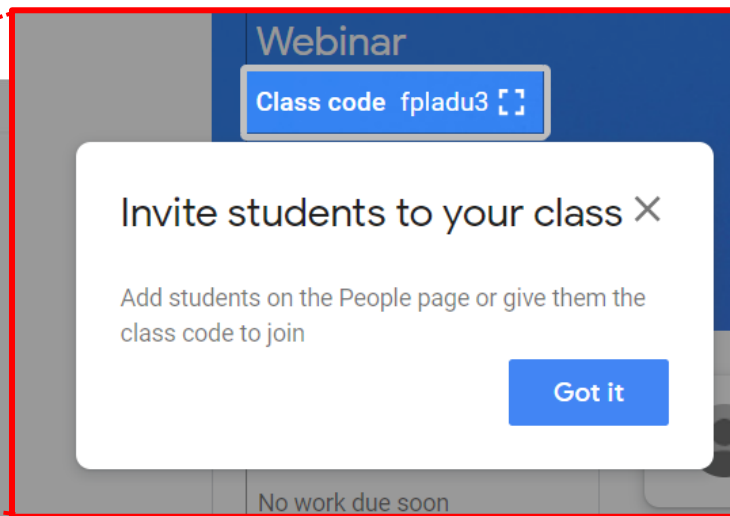

Student View

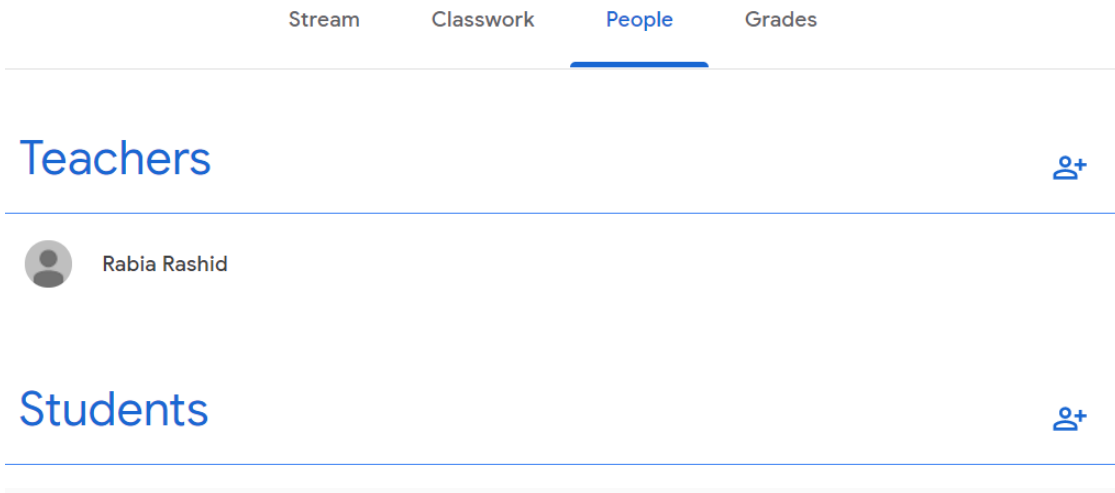
