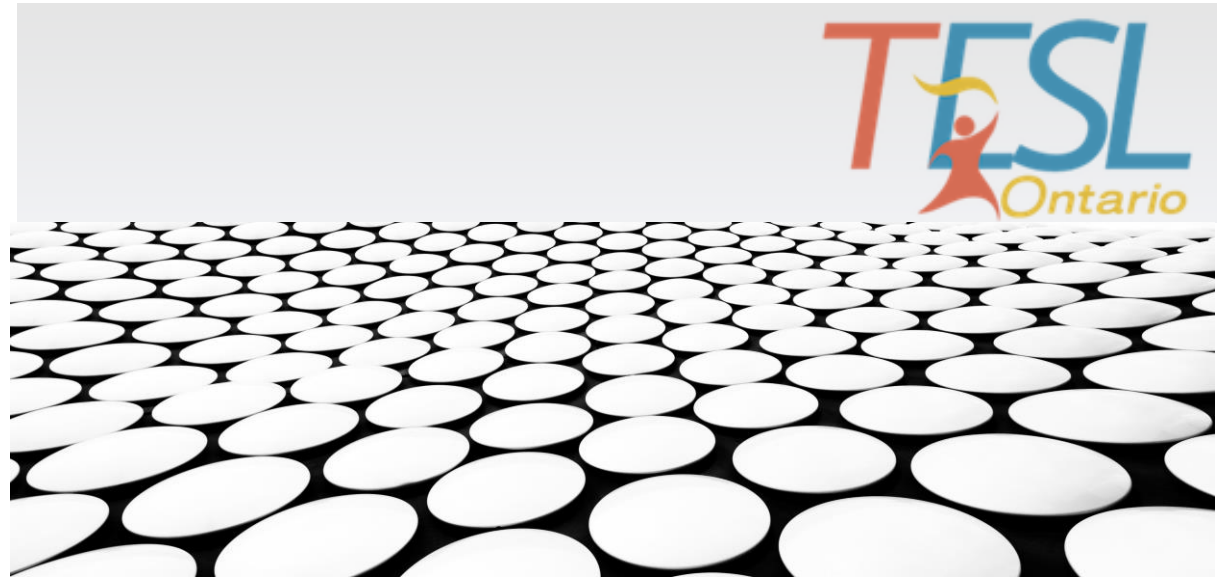

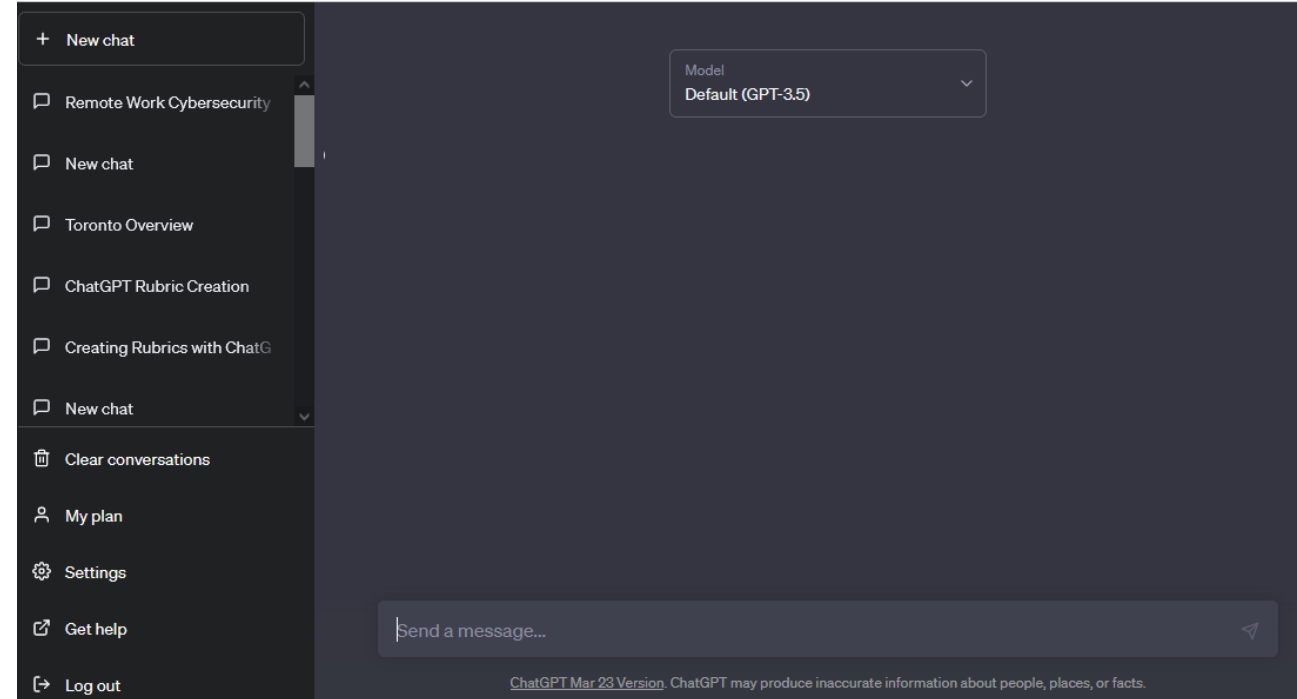

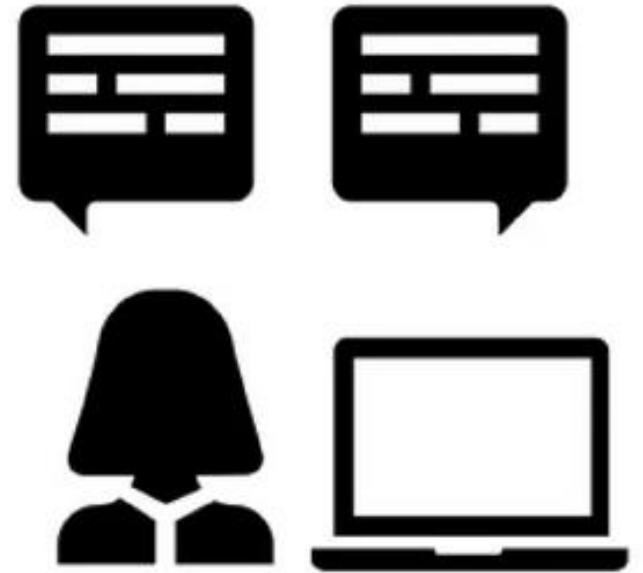

Question or request or statement

- This is the main input provided to ChatGPT. It could be a query, a request for information, or a statement that requires a response.

PROMPT STRUCTURE

- Question, request or statement

ATTRIBUTES

CONTEXT

- Provides setting, environment or background information

“Create at least six conversation prompts for an **English language learning speaking activity at the CEFR B2 level**. The conversations should be about becoming a healthcare professional in **Alberta**.”

ATTRIBUTES

TONE AND STYLE

- Provides register info (formal, casual, intimate, consultative, frozen, humorous,)

“**[Humorous tone]** I need an ice breaker for the first class of an English for specific purposes course for healthcare professionals.”

Ask your students to introduce themselves and share a fun fact related to healthcare. For example, "Hi, my name is John, and I once had to perform CPR on a cat." or "Hello, I'm Sarah, and I can diagnose any disease just by smelling my patient's breath." This should help to break the ice and get everyone laughing and comfortable with each other. Good luck with your class!

- Provides targets to improve the result

"I'm trying to learn Spanish as a new language, and I want to **become fluent as quickly as possible**. What are some effective methods for language learning that can help me reach this goal?"

ATTRIBUTES

ACTOR / ROLE

- Provides actors' perspective in the result

“Create advice given by an **experienced food services manager** to an **inexperienced line cook** in a restaurant.”

PROMPT TIPS-

BE SPECIFIC

■ results in a **more focused and relevant** response



"Tell me about WebQuests,"



"What are WebQuests in a language learning class and the positive outcomes of using ?"

PROMPT TIPS -

COMPLETE SENTENCES

- complete sentences that clearly convey your intent. Avoid using shorthand or fragments.

✗ “healthcare vocabulary”

✓ “Build a list of 10 healthcare vocabulary terms.”

PROMPT TIPS -

BE CLEAR AND CONCISE

- Avoid complex language (use Plain Language)



"I'm planning on taking my students on a trip to Europe and we want to see as much as possible. I'm thinking about going to France, Italy, Spain, Germany, and maybe a few other places. Do you have any recommendations for things to do and see?"



"What are the must-see attractions in France, Italy, Spain, and Germany for a class trip?"

PROMPT TIPS -

USE CORRECT GRAMMAR AND SPELLING

- ChatGPT will have an easier time understanding your prompt if it is grammatically correct and spelled properly.

✗ “whats the best way to make a sandwhich?”

✓ "What is the best way to make a sandwich?"

PROMPT TIPS -

USE PROPER PUNCTUATION

- Use periods, question marks, exclamation marks, commas as you would with your normal writing. Be aware that **using too many punctuation** marks can make your prompts difficult to understand.

"What are the best restaurants in NYC? I'm looking for something fancy."

PROMPT TIPS -

PARENTHESES () BRACKETS []

- Use **parentheses** and **brackets** to provide additional information or clarification.



"Can you recommend a good movie to watch?"



"Can you recommend a good movie to watch? **(Preferably something in the comedy genre.)**"



"How do I make a payment online?"



"How do I make a payment online? **[I'm trying to pay my utility bill.]**"

PROMPT TIPS -

DIFFERENT APPROACHES

- Use different ways of prompt phrasing your prompts.
(see handout for examples)
 - a. Direct question: "What is the capital of France?"
 - b. Yes/No question: "Is Paris the capital of France?"
 - c. Statement: "I'm interested in learning more about French culture."
 - d. Command: "Please provide information on the history of France."
 - e. ...

PROMPT TIPS - **REWRITE**

- Use **rewrite** to improve or tailor the conversation to improve the result of a previous prompt.

Original prompt: "List the best restaurants in San Francisco?"

Response: "Gary Danko, Saison, and Zuni Cafe."

Rewrite prompt : "**Rewrite for Toronto**"

Response: "Richmond Station, Alo and Pai."

PROMPT TIPS -

REWRITE

- Use `format` to create structure to the result as a table, chart, list, or paragraph.
